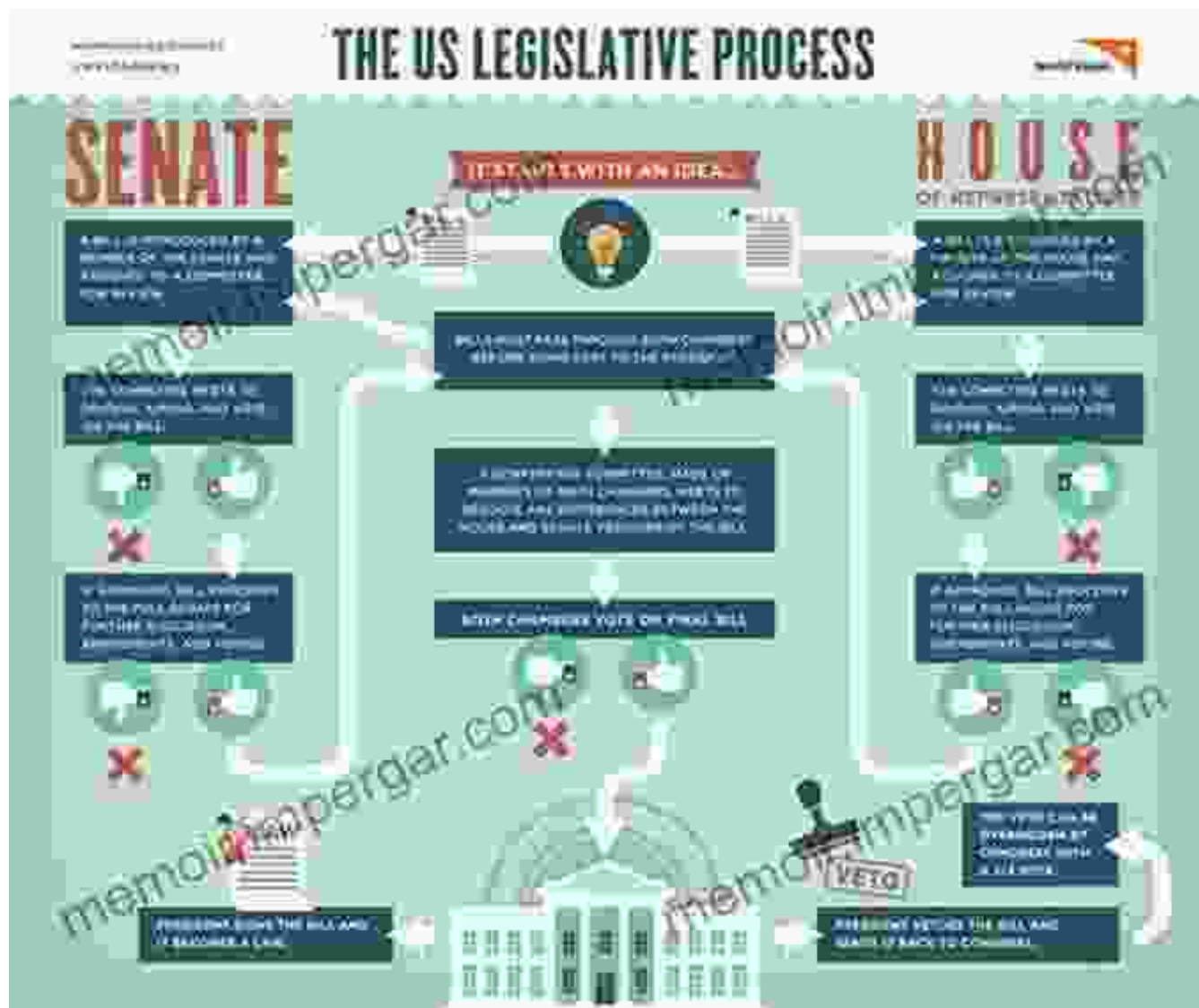

- A comprehensive account of argument must be built upon a philosophical account of rationality (or logic).

o What's logic?

- Science of reasoning, thinking, proof or inference.

• MODES OF LEGAL REASONING

I. Deductive reasoning

Deductive (starts from general statement to reach specific conclusion)

Used to test hypotheses and theories

Premise → second premise = inference

For deductive reasoning to be sound, the hypothesis must be correct

Uses available information facts etc to make conclusions

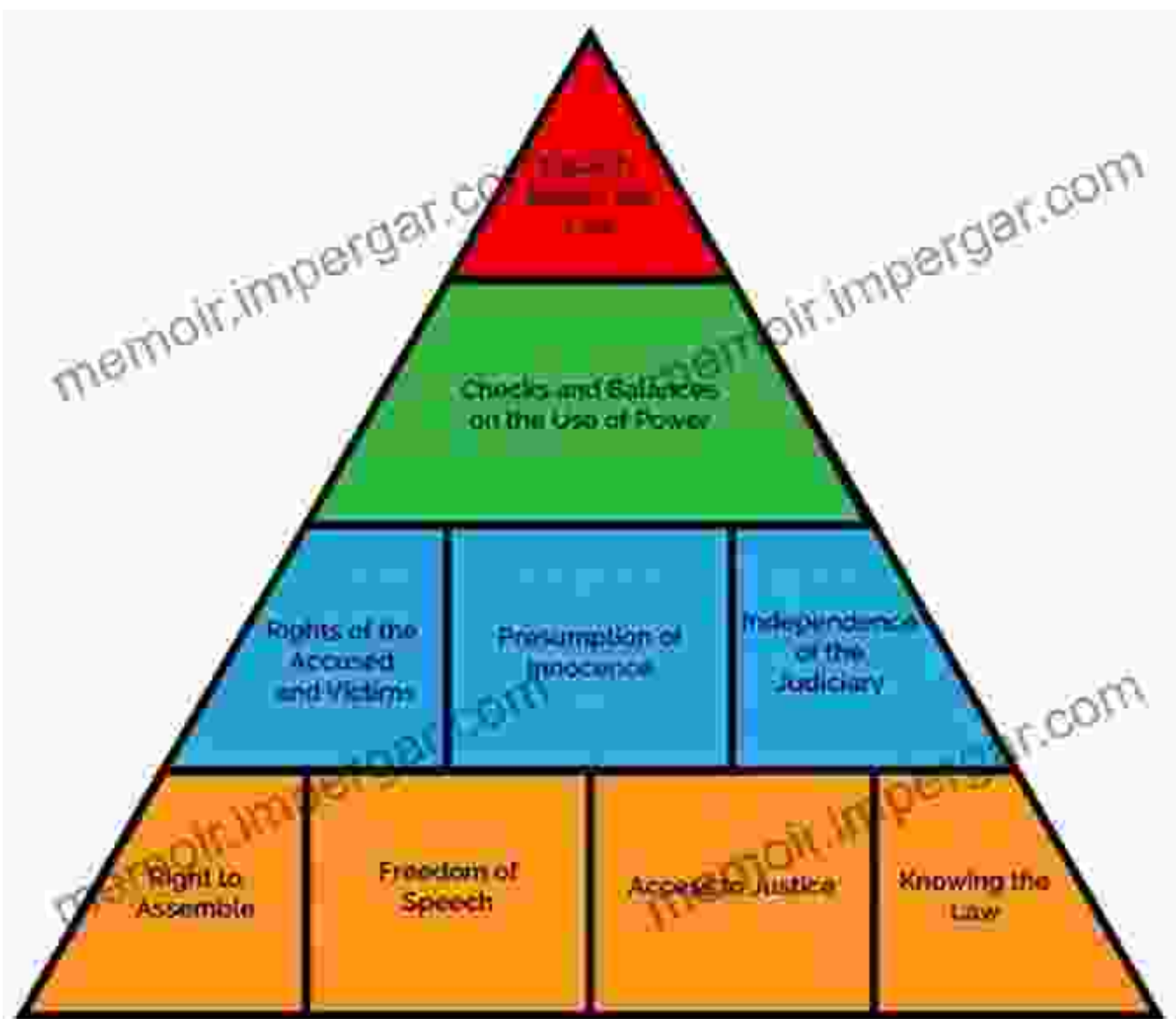
All short haired women are aunts. Anika has short hair. So anika is an aunt.

- Involved reasoning from general rule to the specific
- Starts to general rule and applies to specific case. The connection is the conclusion
- Steps:
 - Major premise
 - ◆ Identifying the rule that may apply to a pattern or fact pattern
 - ◆ Ex: to steal is to act contrary to Art 362 of the Criminal Code
 - Minor premise
 - ◆ Stating the facts in terms of the rule
 - ◆ Ex: Anil has stolen a motorbike
 - Conclusion = reaching conclusion after analyzing those.
