The player to the left of the dealer goes first. On their turn, a player can do one of three things:

- 1. Draw a card from the stock
- 2. Draw a card from the discard pile
- 3. Meld cards

If a player draws a card from the stock, they must then discard a card to the discard pile. If a player draws a card from the discard pile, they do not have to discard a card.

A player can meld cards at any time during their turn. To meld cards, a player must place them face up on the table in front of them. Melds can be either sets or runs.

A set is three or four cards of the same rank. For example, three aces or four kings.

A run is three or more cards of the same suit in sequence. For example, three hearts in a row or four spades in a row.

A player can meld as many cards as they want on their turn. However, a player cannot meld a card that is already part of a meld.

The object of gin rummy is to be the first player to meld all of their cards. When a player melds all of their cards, they go "gin." A gin is worth 25 points. If a player does not go gin, they are penalized 10 points for each card that they have left in their hand.

The first player to reach 100 points wins the game. If both players reach 100 points in the same hand, the player with the higher score wins.

- Oklahoma gin: In Oklahoma gin, players are not allowed to meld cards until they have at least 10 points worth of melds in their hand.
